Our first month... to say it's been an adjustment may be an understatement. We have discovered one thing for sure... that those who return to school after 50 are due much more credit than I have ever given. Another thing, learning a language is a serious challenge. Put the two together... well, welcome to our lives!

We have certainly found our need to call on the Lord, to present ourselves to Him daily, to acknowledge that apart from Him – this is IMPOSSIBLE!!!! So it is with great expectation of what HE WILL DO that we press on into our 6th week of language classes.

Randy and I were able to travel to Kisii the day after arriving in Kenya. It was a rushed but sweet time with our friends. They all send their greetings to "the brothers and sisters in America". It is insightful, the way they see the unity of the church across the globe. Continue to pray for the Holy Spirit to teach His Truth to the hearts of those with ears to hear. Pray that more will open their hearts to hear. Pray for opportunities to share HIS GOSPEL. We are working on our Visa's and are praying

that the Lord will expedite the process. We do not know what will come of the elections March 4 or how they might affect the pending or future Visas. Please keep this in prayer.

Speaking of Elections... Please, keep that in your prayers. We are unsure yet what we will be doing that week. Pray for wisdom. Mostly pray that we would be available to the Lord during this time to share HIS Hope and HIS Peace.

We spent an afternoon with our friends the Compeans. Again, they and their friend Eddie, a missionary from Turkana, encouraged and gave much wisdom and counsel as we shared struggles and concerns. They gave us lots of practical information. Since then, Kelli has gotten news her mom is not doing well. Her cancer is progressed and the prognosis is not good. 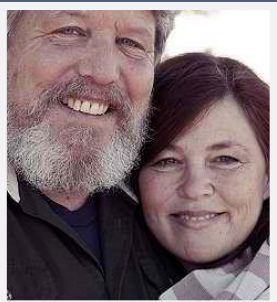
